Just about to do something

Keep under careful observation

Please keep an eye on the baby, I am going downstairs.

8. No hard feelings

No resentment

There are no hard feelings between us.

9. By no means

Not at all

By no means our team will win this match

By no means I am going to accept your request

A final result
