1. Acumen

Adjective

Meaning: Having mixed feelings, uncertain

Sentence:

I am ambivalent about this offer.

9. Anomaly

Noun

Meaning: Different from usual

Sentence:

There was an anomaly in the numbers, which turned out to be a fraud.

10. Embezzlement

Noun

Meaning: To take money of others

Sentence:

He was sacked because of embezzlement.
