- **Meaning:**

A collection of valuable things

- **Sentence:**

- In August, FBI agents seized a trove of documents from Trump's estate, called Mar-a-Lago, in Palm Beach, Florida.

**Noun**

- **Meaning:**

A physical attack

- **Sentence:**

- Assault by Trump supporters on the US Capitol urged the US Justice Department to file criminal charges against the former president.

# 7. Insurrection

**Noun**

- **Meaning:**

A violent uprising against government

- **Sentence:**

- The recommended charges were inciting, assisting or aiding insurrection;



# 8. Defraud

**Verb**

- **Meaning:**

To take something illegally from a person or a company

- **Sentence:**

- The recommended charges were inciting, assisting or aiding insurrection; disrupting an official proceeding; conspiracy to defraud the US;

# 9. Fraudulent

**Adjective**

- **Meaning:**

Involving deception

- **Sentence:**

- Trump, a Republican, raised some \$250m from supporters to advance fraudulent claims in court that he won the election,

# 10. Steer

**Verb**

- **Meaning:**

To take a particular line of action

- **Sentence:**

- Trump, a Republican, raised some \$250m from supporters to advance fraudulent claims in court that he won the election, but steered much of the money elsewhere.

# 11. Pretense

**Noun**

- **Meaning:**

A way of behaving that is intend to deceive people

- **Sentence:**

- This raises the possibility that he could be charged with wire fraud, which prohibits obtaining money on “false or fraudulent pretenses”, legal experts said.

# 12. Lambast

**Verb**

- **Meaning:**

To criticize harshly

- **Sentence:**

- This week, Trump also lambasted Cohen, his former lawyer and a key witness in the New York investigation,
