- **Meaning:**

To meet somebody by chance

- **Sentence:**

1. Yesterday, I ran into my boss at the restaurant.

# 2. BUMP INTO

- **Meaning:**

To meet somebody by chance

To collides

- **Sentence:**

1. Yesterday, I bumped into my boss at the restaurant.

2. I bumped into the table and spilled my coffee.

# 3. GO ON

- **Meaning:**

  - To continue

  - To keep talking about something for a long time

- **Sentence:**

  - 1. let's go on with the studies.

  - 2. He went on and on about his new car.

# 4. PUT UP WITH

- **Meaning:**

To tolerate or endure something unpleasant

- **Sentence:**

She has been putting up with her noisy neighbors for years

# 5. RAMBLE ON

- **Meaning:**

To talk for long time about many points without having a clear direction

- **Sentence:**

- The movie was entertaining at first, but then it started to ramble on and I lost interest.

# 6. GET OVER

- **Meaning:**

To recover and move on from a difficult situation

- **Sentence:**

- 1. It took him a long time to get over the breakup.
  2. Don't worry, you will get over her.

# 7. BREAK DOWN

- **Meaning:**

To stop working

- **Sentence:**

- The car broke down on the highway.



# 8. COME ACROSS

- **Meaning:**

To find or encounter something unexpectedly

- **Sentence:**

- I came across an old photo album while cleaning the store.

# 9. SET UP

- **Meaning:**

To arrange or establish

- **Sentence:**

- 1. He set up a meeting to discuss the project.
  2. I am setting up a birthday party for her.

# 10. FILL IN

- **Meaning:**

1. To provide missing or incomplete information
2. To temporarily substitute for someone who is absent or unavailable

- **Sentence:**

- 1. Please, fill in the form with your personal information.
  2. Can you fill in for me at the meeting tomorrow?
