- To introduce a contrasting or opposing viewpoint or statement

2. ON THE OTHER HAND

- To introduce an alternative perspective
- He is incredibly talented, but on the other hand, he is very expensive.

3. ON A SIDE NOTE

- To introduce an additional point in a conversation or discussion

- Project's deadline is Monday. On a side note, have you seen the latest movie?

4. ON A DIFFERENT NOTE

- This phrase is used to transition to a different topic or subject.

- We've discussed the budget extensively. On a different note, let's talk about our marketing strategy.

6. ON A NEED TO KNOW BASIS

- This phrase means that information is shared only with those who require it for a specific purpose or task
- Confidential client data is shared on a need-to-know basis among the project team.

7. ON A ROLL

- To be experiencing a series of successes or favorable outcomes
- **Ever since he started his new job, he's been on a roll, consistently exceeding his targets and receiving praise from his superiors.**

8. ON A WHIM

- To do something spontaneously or without much thought or planning
- I booked a trip to Paris on a whim and had an amazing time.

9. ON A SILVER PLATTER

- To have something handed to you or provided without any effort or difficulty
- He didn't expect success to come on a silver platter; he worked hard to achieve it.

10. ON A HUNCH

- To have a feeling or intuition about something without concrete evidence

- On a hunch, I decided to invest in that startup, and it turned out to be a great decision.
