1. Repertoire

(Noun)

- **Meaning:**

- A range or collection of skills, abilities, accomplishments, or behaviors that a person or thing possesses or can perform

- **Sentence:**

- The athlete's repertoire of skills includes speed, agility, and precision.

2. Blab

(Verb)

- **Meaning:**

- to reveal or disclose information

- **Sentence:**

- Sarah promised not to blab about the surprise party, but she couldn't keep it a secret.

3. Clasp

(Verb)

- **Meaning:**

- To hold something tightly

- **Sentence:**

The child clasped the doll tightly to her chest.

4. Intricate

(Adjective)

- **Meaning:**

- Very detailed and complicated

- **Sentence:**

The artist created an intricate design on the canvas, using tiny brushstrokes.

5. Vacant

(Adjective)

- **Meaning:**

- Something that is empty, unoccupied, or not in use

- **Sentence:**

The hotel room remained vacant for days, waiting for the next guest to arrive.

6. Discern

(Verb)

- **Meaning:**

- To perceive, recognize, or distinguish something with clarity or accuracy, often through careful observation or mental effort

- **Sentence:**

It was difficult to discern the truth from the conflicting accounts of the witnesses.

7. Touche

(Exclamation)

- **Meaning:**

- An acknowledgement during a discussion of a good or clever point made

- **Sentence:**

In a witty exchange of jokes, one friend laughed and said, "Touche, you got me there."

8. Gravitate

(Verb)

- **Meaning:**

- A natural tendency of an object or person to move toward or be drawn to another object, person, place, or idea.

- **Sentence:**

Employees often gravitate toward positions that offer good salaries and perks.
