# 1 Conjunction

Introduces a clause  
indicating a specific time or  
event from which a situation  
has persisted



***Jub se***

- Since the pandemic began, our lives have been significantly altered.
- Since she took up painting, her creativity has flourished.
- Since the new manager joined the team, productivity has noticeably improved.

## 2 Conjunction

Indicates the reason or cause for something.



***Choonkay***

- Since he forgot his wallet, he couldn't buy anything at the store.
- Since they ran out of gas, they had to pull over to the side of the road.
- Since the alarm didn't go off, they overslept and missed the flight.

# Adjective

*In British English*

Indicates a period of time that has passed since a particular event occurred.



***Ho gaey***

- Two days since they completed the project.
- A month since he graduated from university.
  - Two decades since they got married.
