Refers to not one or the other out of two people or things.

**Refers to one or the other
out of two people or
things.**

Either of the movies makes a great choice for tonight.

Either of the twins is capable of winning the competition.

Either of the roads leads to the city center.

ANY OF

**Refers to one or more
people or things out of a
larger group
(More than 2)**



**Sub main se
koi aik**

Any of the colors will look great in this room.

Any of these books is a good read.

Any of the employees can help you with your request.

BOTH OF

Refers to two people or things together.

**Refers to the entire group
of people or things.**
